

## Falls Cliff Cave

Last Updated Friday, 29 December 2006

(closed cave)

Location: Danby, VT

Description: A fairly difficult marble cave, wet, requiring vertical skills. Very beautiful banded marble in the lower sections of the cave. Located on the Purgatory Karst, this cave has been closed since 1992.
